

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS

Copy of Passport (Bio Data Page)

Scanned copy of bio data page.

Passport Photo

Soft copy of passport size photo in JPEG format.

Cover / Motivational Letter

Letter indicating clear intentions of students for joining BIHC and course of study.

Parents / Sponsor Financial Commitment Letter

Letter from parent and/or sponsor to commit to the full financial support of the student's tuition fees and living expenses.

Passport Copy of Parent / Guardian

Scanned copy of parent/guardian's bio data passport page.

Copy of Academic Certificates

Scanned copy of Original academic certificates. Employer references may also be attached (all documents MUST be in English, where there is need to translate, the translation must be done and certified by a notary and or the relevant embassy)

Copy of E-Visa (If already in Kenya)

Scanned copy of e-visa or any other entry document to the Republic of Kenya.

Proof of Payment of Application Fee

Copy of receipt confirming payment of application fee of KES 7,000. (Use current exchange rate)

Police Clearance from country of origin

Certificate of Clearance/ Conduct from the relevant police post.

NB:

- ✓ The Study Permit typically takes 4-6 weeks to process, from the time of submission of ALL of the above documents.
- ✓ **Nigerian nationals** must secure National Drug Law Enforcement Agency clearance certificate
- ✓ Every foreigner planning to study in Kenya must obtain a visa to enter the country if they are not coming from countries which Kenyan visa requirements do not apply. This can be obtained through the Kenyan Visa e-visa portal <http://evisa.go.ke/evisa.html> at a fee of USD 50.
