

Check-list for East African Applicant

Application Forms should be submitted with the following documents:

- **Certificate of High School**
- **Higher Education** (Certificates, Diploma, Degree) if applicable
- **References:** Any references or letters of recommendations on letterhead from your educational institution and/or employer(s)
- **3 Colored Passport Photos**
- **Copy of Identification** (National ID or Passport)
- **Food Handlers Certificate**
- **Medical Forms:** To be completed when you go for your Food Handlers Certificate from relevant authority in country of origin
- **Personal Statement in support of your application** (300 words)
On a separate sheet of paper please provide information on why you want to study at BIHC. You may wish to include reasons for your program choice, your future career plans and any other information which you feel demonstrates your suitability for the course.
- **Confirmation of Health Insurance Coverage** Comprehensive cover
- **Completed “Fee Payment Options Form”**
- **Certificate of Good Conduct** From relevant authority in country of origin
- **Confirmation of Application Fee Payment** Kshs.1000.00 (non-refundable)
- **Student Pass & Foreign National ID card** Kshs. 2,500.00 (Proof of payment)

Personal Interview
